





# 2006 SEASON IN REVIEW

With a blend of veterans and newcomers and a strong flavoring of international talent, Mississippi State continued its upward climb on the volleyball court in 2006. State fashioned a 17-13 record, the program's most wins since 1996, and made its strongest bid to date at earning a school-first berth in the NCAA tournament.

The 17-win season, coming on the heels of State's 15-12 showing in 2005, gave Mississippi State back-to-back winning campaigns in volleyball for the first time since 1989-1990 and just the second time in the 32-year history of the Mississippi State volleyball program.

Senior outside hitter **Orshi Kriegel**, the lone senior and one of four returning starters on the 2006 edition, easily emerged as Mississippi State's "go-to" player on the court. Kriegel, also the first European to play volleyball at MSU, paced State with 354 kills, averaging 11.8 kills and 9.4 digs. Kriegel hit double-digits in kills in 22 of 30 matches, three times eclipsing the 20-kill mark. And with 281 digs, second-most on the team, she finished the year with a team-best 12 double-doubles.

Two other Bulldogs, junior opposite hitter **Jamie Joyner** and junior setter **Eva Kriegel**, Orshi's younger sister, were major contributors who also drew starts in all 30 matches.

Joyner finished fourth on the club with 243 kills and with 48 total blocks ranked third in that defensive category.

Kriegel, MSU's primary setter, tallied 1,120 assists (ninth-most in a season at State). But she also proved to be a force in so many other ways. She paced State and ranked second in the SEC with 57 service aces (eighth-most in a season at MSU), ranked third on the team with 225 digs, second on the club with 49 total blocks and a surprising fifth in kills with 194. Kriegel's versatility enabled her to record four "triple-doubles", the most in the SEC in 2006. For her exploits she was honored as the team's most valuable player.

The Bulldogs got solid play at the net in 2006 from junior middle blocker **Erin Seago**. Seago, who played in all 103 games and started 29 of 30 matches, paced MSU with 74 total blocks, including a team-high 14 solo stops. She delivered 156 kills while hitting at a crisp team-best .363 clip, fifth-best in the Southeastern Conference.

Junior libero **Megan Lukasek**, after missing the first seven matches of the campaign due to injury, returned to the MSU lineup during the MSU/Microtel Classic. Despite the slow start, Lukasek led MSU with 295 digs, ranking eighth in the SEC with a 3.69 per-game digs total.

The Bulldogs opened the campaign in impressive fashion, rolling to wins in nine of their first 10 matches in non-conference play. State claimed tournament titles at the **Capital One Classic** in Lafayette, La., and the **MSU/Microtel Classic** in Starkville and took runner-up honors in the **Regency Suites Midtown Invitational** in Atlanta, Ga.

Mississippi State successfully opened the SEC's new 20-match scheduling format Sept. 13 with a straight-sets home

court win over instate league rival Mississippi. It would be the first of a school-record eight league wins for MSU, bettering State's six-win showing against league competition in 2005. Half of those wins came against teams that advanced to NCAA post-season play.

There were some notable league wins along the way. State bested SEC East rival South Carolina in a regionally-televised match in Columbia, S.C., Oct. 15 and completed the series sweep with a straight-sets win over USC in Starkville Nov. 3, marking MSU's first series sweep of the Gamecocks since 1991. A 3-1 win Oct. 18 over instate Mississippi in Oxford, Miss., gave State its third straight series sweep of the Lady Rebels and extending MSU's win streak over UM to six matches, the longest such win streak for State against a conference opponent.

State also reached previously uncharted territory in its 2006 season finale against Arkansas Nov. 19. Arkansas had claimed all 26 previous meetings before State registered a breakthrough straight-sets win over the Lady Razorbacks, one of seven SEC teams to advance to the NCAA Tournament. The win was the 10th of the season at the Newell-Grisson Building for MSU, a school-record for Mississippi State wins in 10 seasons at its current home arena and for all-time wins at home wins.

Here are some other noteworthy achievements of the

**TEAM MVP** --- Junior setter **Eva Kriegel**, who for the second season registered an SEC-leading four "triple-doubles", was selected team MVP for 2006. The Jaszbereny, Hungary, native led Mississippi State with 57 service aces and 1,120 assists. She also registered 194 kills, 225 digs and 49 total blocks.

**ACADEMIC HONORS** --- Eleven members of the 2006 MSU volleyball team were accorded academic all-conference honors. **Jamie Joyner**, **Cristina Jucan**, **Lauren Kowal**, **Orshi Kriegel**, **Megan Lukasek** and **Erin Seago** were named to the **SEC Volleyball Academic Honor Roll** while **Ioana Demian**, **Dorey Gray**, **Jennifer Hausley**, **Stefanie Joiner** and **Emily Tooker** earned placed on the **SEC Freshman Academic Honor Roll** for 2006. Stefanie

Joiner also was honored as the recipient of MSU's **Newsom Award** as volleyball's top scholar-athlete. Her older sister, current MSU senior **Jamie Joyner**, won the award in 2005.

**FRESHMAN AWARD** --- Rookie outside hitter **Martina Gregusova** became the first MSU player honored named to the **SEC All-Freshman Team**. The Nitra, Slovakia, native, a three-time **SEC Freshman of the Week** selection, finished third on the team with 245 kills.

**CLIMBING MSU'S COACHING WIN CHARTS** --- With 17 wins in 2006, MSU head volleyball coach climbed from seventh to a tie for third on the MSU career wins chart. Seals now sports a 46-41 career record at State. With a school-record eight SEC wins last fall, Seals now stands second on State's career SEC wins list with 19.
