THE STARTING FIVE

► No. 10 Oklahoma looks to move to 2-1 in SEC play on Thursday night when it travels to Starkville to face Mississippi State. The **Sooners (13-2, 1-1 SEC)** are fresh off a top-15 win at Tennessee, while the **Bulldogs (13-3, 0-2 SEC)** enter the night after back-to-back losses to ranked teams.

▶The Sooners are a perfect **4-0 on the road** this season, highlighted by a ranked win over then-No. 22 Louisville and last week at #15 Tennessee. Their four-game road winning streak is the 10th longest in the nation. Under fourth-year head coach Jennie Baranczyk, Oklahoma has posted a strong 29-11 record in true road games.

▶ OU has one of the most explosive and efficient offenses in the country, ranking **5th in scoring offense (90.1 PPG)**, 12th in field goal percentage (48.5%), 2nd in assists per game (22.6 APG) and it leads the nation in rebounds per game (49.93 RPG). **The Sooners rank in the top 10 nationally in paint points (45.6, 2nd), second chance points (15.8, 9th) and bench points (34.8, 5th).**

▶The Sooners enter Thursday's contest ranked No. 11 in the latest NET rankings. Oklahoma is 4-2 in Quad 1/2 games, including top-25 victories over Michigan, Louisville and Tennessee, plus a road win at UNLV. They've dominated Quad 3/4 games, going 9-0 with an average margin of victory of 38.2 points. Ten of OU's final 14 conference games are against Quad 1/2 teams.

▶While Oklahoma's offense often steals the spotlight, the Sooners' defense is equally impressive. Ranked 19th nationally in defensive rating, it allows just 79.3 points per 100 possessions. **Oklahoma has held 14 of its 15 opponents below their season averages in both points and shooting percentage.** On average, the Sooners limit opponents to 9.0 fewer points per game and force them to shoot 6.0% worse from the field.

NOTE OF THE NIGHT

▶ Raegan Beers, named to the Wooden Award Top 25 Midseason Watch List on Tuesday, averages 17.1 points and 9.3 rebounds in just 21.5 minutes per game. Her 69.1% field goal percentage ranks third nationally, while her player efficiency rating (PER) of 38.9 places her 13th in Division I. Beers has recorded six double-doubles in 15 games this season, the second-most by a Sooner in a single season since 2017-18, ranking in the top 30 nationally. **Beers was the No. 1 player in the transfer portal per The Athletic and 247 Sports, and No. 2 by ESPN.**

▶ The Oklahoma women's basketball team took the lead in the first quarter and dominated Mississippi State in Norman on Saturday, knocking off the Bulldogs 94-63 as part of the Big 12/SEC Challenge. The 31-point win marked the largest non-conference margin of victory over a Power Five opponent since a 39-point win vs. Oregon on Nov. 24, 2012. With the victory over Mississippi State, the Sooners (7-1) extended their winning streak to four games.

LAST TIME OUT: #9 OKLAHOMA 87, #15 TENNESSEE 86

▶ Payton Verhulst scored 16 points including two free throws with 50 seconds left in the game to help No. 9 Oklahoma hold on for an 87-86 win over No. 15 Tennessee on Sunday. The Volunteers (13-1, 1-1 in Southeastern Conference) rallied from a 19-point third-quarter deficit. They scored eight points in the final 1:15 of the game, led by two 3-pointers from Jewel Spear, who finished with 28 points. Sara Puckett's 3-point attempt with five seconds left that would have won the game for Tennessee missed.

A WIN WOULD...

- ▶ Push Oklahoma's winning streak on the road to five games.
- ▶ Secure the Sooners' 13th straight win over unranked opponents, a streak that dates back to last season.

NEW CONFERENCE, SAME GOALS

- ►The 2024-25 season marks Oklahoma's inaugural campaign in the Southeastern Conference (SEC), officially joining the league on July 1, 2024.
- ▶ Oklahoma was **picked to finish fourth in both the SEC media and coaches' preseason polls**. In Coach Baranczyk's three seasons at OU, her teams have outperformed their preseason projections each time. Across her 12-year head coaching career (nine seasons at Drake and three at OU), Baranczyk's teams have met or exceeded preseason expectations in 10 seasons.
- ▶ Entering the season, under Baranczyk, Oklahoma was 7-4 vs. teams in the SEC, and 4-1 vs. SEC teams that were in the league prior to this season.
- ►In Oklahoma's 28 years in the Big 12 Conference, Oklahoma won 12 conference championships, reaching the NCAA Tournament 21 times. All-time, Oklahoma posted a 367-269 record vs. Big 12 teams.

50 YEARS AT LLOYD NOBLE CENTER

- ▶ This season marks Oklahoma's 50th at Lloyd Noble Center, where the Sooners got their first home win on Jan. 31, 1976, with a 44-38 win over East Central (Okla.). In total, the Sooners have amassed a 468-173 (.727) record at the LNC, welcoming over 1.97 million fans through its doors. The program set a historic milestone by winning 25 consecutive games at the arena from 1984 to 1986.
- ▶ In the Baranczyk era, Oklahoma has posted a 47-8 home record, including a 23-5 mark in home conference play and a 24-3 record in home non-conference matchups.
- ► The arena is tied with Stegeman Coliseum, Pete Maravich Assembly Center and Humphrey Coliseum as the oldest arena in the league.

PULSE OF THE POLLS

- ▶ Oklahoma is the No. 10 team in the AP Poll and the Sooners have been ranked in the top 15 all season, rising as high as No. 8 in the Nov. 25 poll. The Sooners checked in at No. 11 in the WBCA Coaches Poll on Jan. 7.
- ▶ OU opened the 2024-25 season ranked 10th in both the AP and WBCA Coaches polls, marking the team's highest preseason ranking since 2010. It was also Oklahoma's first top-10 appearance in the AP poll since Nov. 18, 2013, when the team was similarly ranked at No. 10.
- ▶ Oklahoma currently boasts an active streak of 18 consecutive weeks in the AP poll, the fifth longest in program history. The active streak is the longest stretch since a 40-week period between 2015-17.

THE MARCH TO MADNESS

- ►In the latest ESPN bracketology on Jan. 7, Oklahoma was tabbed as a **No. 3 seed**, which would provide hosting duties in the tournament for the second time of the Baranczyk era (2022).
- ► A staple of the NCAA postseason, Oklahoma has appeared in 24 NCAA Tournaments, including 22 since the turn of the century and three straight under Baranczyk.
- ▶ Of Oklahoma's 29 regular season opponents, 11 are in the latest bracket on ESPN, including three from its non-conference slate (Duke [L], Louisville [W] and Michigan [W]).

EXPERIENCE PAYING DIVIDENDS

- ▶ Oklahoma doesn't just return talent it returns experienced talent. The Sooners have combined to play over 1,000 games in their careers. **The 14-player roster has amassed 506 combined starts.**
- ▶The Sooners' projected starting five boasts 321 combined starts, led by Nevaeh Tot's 120 as the veteran guard has **started 99 straight games** for Baranczyk. Other projected starters include Skylar Vann (54 starts), Raegan Beers (52), Sahara Williams (48) and Payton Verhulst (47). Vann, Williams and Verhulst started 31 games together last season.
- ▶Off the bench, Aubrey Joens has played in a team-high 137 games, and Lexy Keys owns 105 starts in 134 games.
- Six Sooners have graduated with undergraduate degrees and are pursuing their graduate degrees.

ROSTER LOADED WITH TALENT

- ▶ Oklahoma's experienced roster draws plenty of attention, but it's no secret that the Sooners are also one of the most talented teams in the nation.
- ►The Sooners' starting five features three McDonald's All-Americans (Beers, Verhulst, Williams) while OU's remaining two starters include Skylar Vann, the 2024 Big 12 Player of the Year, and Tot, who is a two-time All-Big 12 honoree.
- ► Five Oklahoma players were five-star recruits in high school: Sahara Williams, Payton Verhulst, Aubrey Joens, Liz Scott, and Raegan Beers.
- ► Additionally, eight members of the 14-player roster were ranked as top-100 players in their class by ESPN: Raegan Beers (#10), Payton Verhulst (#12), Sahara Williams (#23), Zya Vann (#46), Aubrey Joens (#52), Caya Smith (#72), Liz Scott (#76), and Beatrice Culliton (#96).

SCORING STAMPEDE

► If you want to see one of the fastest and most prolific offenses in the country, then watch OU basketball. The Sooners are the only team in the country to average 80+ PPG every season since 2021-22. Since Baranczyk arrived in Norman, OU has averaged 81.6 points per game.

- ▶ Oklahoma's 90.1 points per game in 2024-25 rank fifth nationally and the Sooners' FG% of 48.5% is the 12th highest in Division I. Additionally, 0U's 22.6 assists per game rank second in Division I.
- ► Baranczyk's teams are known for prolific offense and the head coach has delivered in Norman. In her Oklahoma tenure, the Sooners have **posted 90+ points 35 times** (2nd in NCAA since start of 2021-22 season) and have won 33 straight when scoring 90 in games that don't go to overtime.
- ▶ Since the start of the 2021-22 season, Oklahoma has eclipsed 100 points 10 times, the fourth most nationally.
- ▶ Oklahoma's offensive rating of 111.8 ranks 24th nationally and **the Sooners average 45.6 paint points per game, good for second most in the nation**. The Sooner bench adds 34.8 PPG (5th NCAA) with three reserves adding 7.0+ PPG.
- ►The Sooners have reached 70 points in all 15 games this season, the second-longest streak under Baranczyk, who opened her tenure at Oklahoma by scoring 70+ in a program-record 18 consecutive games in 2021-22.

GLASS CLEANERS

- ►The Sooners lead nation in rebounding 49.33 RPG) and are second in rebounding margin (17.5) while pulling in a nation-high 33.9 defensive rebounds per game.
- ▶ Oklahoma is 27-0 under Baranczyk when grabbing 50 or more rebounds and is 68-13 over the last four seasons when winning the rebounding battle.
- ▶This season, OU is 13-1 when outrebounding its opponent.

LOCK DOWN DEFENSE

- ► While Oklahoma's offense often steals the spotlight, the Sooners' defense is equally impressive. Ranked 19th nationally in defensive rating, it allows just 79.3 points per 100 possessions. **Oklahoma has held 14 of its 15 opponents below their season averages in both points and shooting percentages.** On average, the Sooners limit opponents to nine fewer points per game and force them to shoot 6.0% worse from the field.
- ► OU's defensive rating of 79.3 would be **Oklahoma's best DTRG since 2006.**
- ► Transfer center Raegan Beers has been a difference maker in the interior. She ranks in the top 10 in the SEC with 1.2 blocks per game and OU's DRTG ranks in the 98th percentile when she is on the floor. Beers leads the Sooners with a +/- of +282 (+18.8 avg).

- ▶ Oklahoma ranks second nationally in assists per game (22.6) and has dished out 20 dimes nine different times this season.
- ▶ Oklahoma's 33 assists in the OT loss vs. #13 Duke (Nov. 27) were the second most assists for a team vs. a top-25 since 1999, trailing only Duke's 38 assists vs. the Sooners in the same game. The Sooners are the only team in the country with multiple 30-assist games this season OU has four while the rest of D1 combines for nine.
- ▶ Nine different Sooners have at least one career game with five or more assists: Nevaeh Tot (48), Payton Verhulst (17), Skylar Vann (7), Reyna Scott (5), Lexy Keys (4), Zya Vann (2), Sahara Williams (1), Aubrey Joens (1) and Beatrice Culliton (1). Seven of them have at least one game with five dimes this season..

SOONER MAGIC

►The Sooners have used Sooner Magic to **come back from double-digit deficits 16 times** in the Baranczyk era to win, including six times vs. ranked opponents.

- ▶ Oklahoma is no stranger to winning close games it is **15-1 in games decided by one possession** (3 pts or less) under Baranczyk, winning on a last-possession shot five times.
- ► Since the beginning of the 2021-22 season, Oklahoma has a 30-9 record in contests decided by single digits.
- ► OU trailed #13 Duke (Nov. 27) by 15 points before storming back to force OT where it eventually fell 109-99. In the next game, the Sooners erased a 17-point deficit to knock off #22 Louisville on the road on Dec. 4.

NUMBERS NEVER LIE

▶ Over the last four years, Oklahoma is 46-2 under Baranczyk (11-0 in 24-25) when holding opponents under 70 points. On the flip side, the

Sooners are 61-3 under Baranczyk (10-0 in 24-25) when scoring 80 points or more. OU is just 26-25 when scoring less than 80.

▶ Perhaps the most indicative recipe for success is that Oklahoma is **73-2 under Baranczyk (12-0 in 24-25) when shooting a better percentage from the floor than the opponent** and has won 63 of its last 64 when doing so. OU is 69-8 when holding its opponent under 42% from the floor and 12-0 this season. When OU's opponent shoots 40% or worse, the Sooners are 57-3 in the JB era. Since 2021-22, Oklahoma is 68-13 when winning the rebounding battle.

BREWING SUCCESS: RAEGAN BEERS STARRING AT OKLAHOMA

- ▶ In her debut season wearing the Crimson and Cream, All-American transfer Raegan Beers has made an immediate impact The dominant center averages 17.1 points on 69.1% shooting (3rd NCAA) and adds 9.3 rebounds per game. She has secured six double-doubles in 14 games and has scored 10+ in 21 of her last 22.
- ► Beers would be just the third player since 1999 to average 17.0 PPG at 69% shooting or better if she were to maintain her averages.

BFFRS OVER LAST FIVE GAMES

- ►In Oklahoma's win vs. DePaul (Nov. 25) Beers became the first Sooner and third player since 1999 to post 15+ points, 8+ rebounds and shoot 100% from the floor with six FGM in less than 15 minutes of action.
- ▶ The 6'4" post from Littleton, Colo. (Valor Christian HS) made her way to Norman via the transfer portal after two illustrious seasons at Oregon State. Multiple publications named her the No. 1 player in the transfer portal. In her second game at OU she became the first Sooner in over nine years to post a double-double in the first half, tallying 18 points and 11 boards in the first half vs. Virginia (Nov. 8).
- ▶ Beers swept national and SEC honors on Nov. 11 after averaging 23.5 points and 14.0 rebounds per game in the opening week of the season. The junior All-American was named AP National Player of the Week, SEC Player of the Week, and to the USBWA National Starting Five. Beers is the first Sooner to win an SEC weekly award and the first since Courtney Paris in 2009 to win a national player of the week honor.
- ► She scored 26 points in OU's win over Virginia (Nov. 8) and eclipsed 1,000 career points in the effort, reaching the milestone in 63 career games. Beers poured in 28 points on 11-of-13 shooting in OU's win over Omaha on December 22, matching her career high.
- ► Her player efficiency rating (PER) of 38.9 ranks 13th nationally and she was named to the Wooden Award Midseason Watch List on Jan. 7.

THE P STANDS FOR PLAYMAKER

- ▶ Payton Verhulst, nicknamed "P", enters her senior season after a strong junior campaign that saw her win Big 12 Newcomer of the Year honors. The do-it-all guard will look to improve on her breakout season in 2024-25. Verhulst has received a waiver to return to the Sooners for the 2025-26 season.
- ► The do-it-all guard is the only player nationally averaging 14.0 PPG, 5.5 RPG and 3.5 APG in under 27.0 MPG. When her averages are adjusted to per/40 minutes, Verhulst averages 21.2 PPG, 8.8 RPG, 5.7 APG, 2.0 SPG and 1.2 BPG.
- ► She is on a tear offensively and has made multiple 3-pointers in 10 of her last 12 games, and at least a trio of treys eight times in the same stretch.
- ► Verhulst posted Oklahoma's fourth triple-double (29 points, 10 rebounds, 10 assists) in program history vs. No. 13 Duke on Nov. 27. **She became one of two players (joining Caitlin Clark) since 1999 to post a 25-point triple-double against a top-25 team.** Since 1999, just seven players have achieved the 13-6-5-1 line, with only two from high-major conferences. **Verhulst was named SEC Co-Player of the Week for her effort.**
- ▶The former five-star prospect that spent two years at Louisville before transferring to OU in December 2022 averaged 12.6 points, 5.8 rebounds, 3.9 assists, 1.2 steals and 1.0 blocks per game last season. She was the only Division I player to average 12.5 PPG, 5.8 RPG and 3.9 APG in under 30 MPG in 2023-24.
- ▶The 6'1" guard was tabbed as the No. 12 recruit in the 2021 class and was a McDonald's All-American. A finalist for the 2021 USA Today National Female Athlete of the Year award, the Naismith second-team high school All-American was named to the 2022 ACC All-Freshman team after posting 3.3 points and 1.9 rebounds as a freshman at Louisville.

SKY IS THE LIMIT

- ► Skylar Vann is back at Oklahoma for her final season in 2024-25. The fifth-year senior entered the year as a preseason All-SEC second-team selection and a Naismith Trophy POTY watch listee. The reigning Big 12 Player of the Year and All-America honorable mention last season was also the Big 12's only two-time Sixth Player of the Year (2022, 2023) and averaged career highs in points (15.1) and rebounds (7.0) last season.
- ▶The forward has been Ms. Reliable in 2024-25, averaging 10.1 points, 4.9 rebounds and shoots 43% from the floor.
- ► Vann neared a triple-double in OU's win over Omaha on Dec. 22, posting 12 points, eight rebounds and a career-high eight assists.
- ►In the last 16 years of women's college basketball, there have only been two seasons in which a player with one or fewer starts and at least 15 GP has averaged 11.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game **Vann is responsible for both (2022 and 2023).**
- ► She is one of six Sooners ever to score 1,600 career points and notch 800 career rebounds joining Courtney Paris, Caton Hill, Madi Williams, Molly McGuire and Phylesha Whaley.

THE LITTLE ENGINE THAT DOES

- ► For the fifth year in a row, **Nevaeh Tot** will take the ball up the floor for the Oklahoma Sooners. The always steady point guard has **started in 99 consecutive games** for the Sooners and owns a team-high 120 starts. **OU is 88-32 when Tot starts at point guard.**
- ► She enters Sunday with an assist/turnover ratio of 2.22 (7th SEC), which would be the second best A/TO of her career. Through 15 games, the guard has only given it away 27 times despite OU's pace of 80.0 possessions/game. In 122 minutes played in the month of December, the point guard dished out 26 assists and turned it over only 5 times.
- ►The guard was pivotal in Oklahoma's resurgence in conference play last season. She averaged 5.2 assists per game in conference play and led the Big 12 with an assist/turnover ratio of 3.0. **Her 542 career dimes rank fifth in Oklahoma history** as the guard reached 500 assists in OU's win vs. UNLV on Nov. 22.
- ▶ In Oklahoma's win at Wichita State on Nov. 19, 2024, Tot became the only active Division I player 5'3" or shorter with 400 career points, rebounds and assists against Division I competition in their career.
- ► Tot, an All-Big 12 honoree in 2023-24, posted 150 assists last season becoming the first Sooner to hit 150 dimes in a decade (Morgan Hook, 2013-14). She became the fourth Sooner ever to post four straight seasons with 100+ assists, joining elite company in Stacey Dales, Danielle Robinson and Dionnah Jackson.

▶ She is the daughter of Helen Darling, the 2000 Big Ten Player of the Year who led Penn State to the Final Four. Her father, Orlando, played men's basketball at PSU and she is a triplet as her brothers Jalen and Jajuan are standout basketball players at Montana State-Billings.

SOPHOMORE SENSATION SAHARA WILLIAMS

- ► An All-Big 12 honorable mention last season as a freshman, **Sahara Williams** is having a breakout sophomore season for the Sooners. A **preseason watch listee for the Cheryl Miller Award**, the Waterloo, lowa, product has carried the momentum from a strong close to last season into 2024-25.
- ► She averages 10.4 points per game on 46% shooting this season and adds 4.4 RPG and 2.3 APG. The wing has scored in double figures in 12 of her last 19 games dating back to last season, including an **18-point outing on Dec. 29 vs. New Mexico State.**
- ▶The five-star prospect who was a McDonald's All-America prep star, started all 33 games for the Sooners last year, averaging 10.3 points, 5.4 rebounds and 1.5 assists. Her three double-doubles were the third most all-time for an OU freshman behind Courtney Paris and Madi Williams.
- ►Her 19 games in double figures last year were the fifth-most at Oklahoma in the last 15 years as the forward shot 46.3% from the floor.

- ▶The Sooners return to Norman on Sunday to face Texas A&M at Lloyd Noble Center. Tip is set for 4 p.m. on ESPN2.
- ▶The meeting is the 49th between the former Big 12 foes.

ennie Baranczyk was named the ninth head coach of the Oklahoma women's basketball program on April 10, 2021. She will enter her fourth season at the helm in 2024-25 and usher the program into a new chapter in the Southeastern Conference.

Baranczyk (pronounced buh-RON-check), a 13-year head coach, spent nine seasons at Drake before starting her Oklahoma tenure in 2021-22. In each of her first three seasons in Norman, Baranczyk was a National Coach of the Year semifinalist and was named the 2024 Big 12 Coach of the Year. Her 74-26 (.740) record through three seasons is the best three-year start in program history.

Her teams have reached 20 wins in nine of the last 10 seasons, including three consecutive 23-plus wins at Oklahoma. She's led her teams to six NCAA Tournaments and produced 34 all-conference honorees over the previous 12 seasons.

Baranczyk delivered the program's second-straight Big 12 Conference regular season championship during her third campaign as the Sooners' head coach. Her efforts earned her Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, and she was a semifinalist for the Naismith National Coach of the Year award. The conference title was OU's first outright conference title since 2009, as OU compiled a 15-3 league record and a 23-10 overall record. Oklahoma was tabbed as a fifth seed in the program's third consecutive NCAA Tournament, where Baranczyk led OU to the second round.

Baranczyk and her staff saw Skylar Vann claim OU's first Big 12 Player of the Year honor in 15 years, while Payton Verhulst was named the league's Newcomer of the Year. Four Oklahoma players received All-Big 12 honors, with Vann and Verhulst making the first team and Nevaeh Tot and Sahara Williams receiving honorable mentions. Vann and Verhulst both earned All-America honors, pushing Baranczyk's All-America total to five as the Oklahoma head

In her second season, Baranczyk guided the Sooners to their first Big 12 championship since 2009, sharing the regular season title with a 14-4 record in league play and a 26-7 overall record. OU also made its second consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance under Baranczyk. The Sooners secured a program-record six sweeps in league play and secured the most conference wins in 13 seasons.

Baranczyk's coaching saw Madi Williams selected unanimously to the All-Big 12 First Team, while Taylor Robertson and Ana Llanusa received second-team honors, and Skylar Vann received an honorable mention. Vann also won the Sixth Player Award for the second year in a row, and freshman Beatrice Culliton was named to the All-Freshman team. Additionally, Williams became OU's first WNBA Draft Pick since 2013 and earned WBCA and AP All-America honors along with Robertson.

In her debut season, Baranczyk orchestrated one of the greatest turnarounds in the country, guiding the Sooners to a 25-9 record and into the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The 13-win improvement from the season before Baranczyk's arrival was the second-largest turnaround in program history. The Des Moines, lowa, product was named a WBCA National Coach of the Year finalist for her efforts. In addition, the team reached 20 wins faster than all but two teams in program history, rising to No. 12 in the AP Poll midway through the season. Madi Williams and Taylor Robertson earned unanimous All-Big 12 first-team selections, while Skylar Vann was named the league's Sixth Player of the Year.

She coached two Sooners, Taylor Robertson and Madi Williams, to unanimous first-team All-Big 12 selections, the first Sooner pair to do so since 2012. Under Baranczyk's watch, Skylar Vann was named the 2022 Big 12 Sixth Player of the Year and a league honorable mention, and Kelbie Washington earned All-Big 12 Freshman Team honors. Robertson became OU's first All-America selection since Aaryn Ellenberg in 2014, earning an honorable mention.

Baranczyk came to OU after amassing a 192-96 (.667) record at Drake and leading the Bulldogs to six consecutive 20-win seasons (2014-15 through 2019-20) and three NCAA tournament berths (2017-19). A two-time Missouri Valley Conference Coach of the Year, Baranczyk's .667 winning percentage ranks fifth in the league's history.

Baranczyk won back-to-back MVC Coach of the Year awards after her team's historic 2016-17 and 2017-18 campaigns. She led the Bulldogs to an 18-0 regular-season conference record both years and won both MVC Tournaments. After the 2018-19 squad posted a 17-1 league record, the Bulldogs had amassed a near-perfect three-year MVC mark of 53-1 (.981).

Baranczyk began her coaching career in the Big 12 Conference, serving first as an assistant coach at Kansas State during the 2005-06 season (the Wildcats won the WNIT) and returning to the league as an assistant coach at Colorado from 2010-12. Between her Big 12 stints, Baranczyk was an assistant coach at Marquette from 2006-10, helping the Golden Eagles to an 81-53 record and four postseason appearances. The 2007-08 squad won the WNIT title.

Formerly Jennie Lillis, Baranczyk spent her collegiate career at the University of Iowa (2000-04) and is regarded as one of the best all-around players in Hawkeye women's basketball history.

Baranczyk, who obtained a master's degree in counseling and student development from Kansas State in 2006, is married. She and her husband, Scott, have a son, Eli, and two daughters, Jordi and Hope






