·The Bears' 16-1 record at home marked their best record at home in program history other than the 1982-83 season, when it finished a perfect 13-0 in Berkeley. The 16 wins at home is a program record beating the previous record of 15 set in 2012-13.

·The Bears' 25 wins this season are the most in a season since the 2012-13 season when it won 32 games.

Other notables for the the 2024-25 season:

- 1st NCAA Tournament appearance since 2018-19. Cal entered the AP Top 25 for the first time since 2018-19 going as high as No. 18 and maintained
- a ranking for eight straight weeks. During ACC conference and tournament play Cal traveled over 22,600 air miles - the most of any team in the country except Stanford.
- After setting a program record for single-season 3-pointers last season, Cal broke it again this year with 294 triples and counting.
- Two ranked wins (#19 Alabama, #21 NC State) and two over teams receiving votes (Stanford, Georgia Tech)
- 1 of 3 teams in the NCAA Tournament with five players averaging 10+ points per game.
- The sweep against Stanford was the first in the series since the 1985-86 season.

A win against Mississippi State would be Cal's first tournament win since beating North Carolina in the first round of the 2019 tournament.

Cal went 9-6 against teams from the 2024 NCAA Tournament with wins over #19 Alabama, #21 NC State, Florida State, Gonzaga, Auburn, Arizona, Syracuse and Stanford (twice).

Five of the Bears' eight losses this season have come against teams who were ranked or receiving votes at the time.

Cal is 1 of 33 teams in the country with at least three Ouad 1 wins.

Ioanna Krimili earned All-ACC Second-Team honors and was named to the 2024-25 USBWA Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Year Watch List.

Marta Suarez earned All-Tournament Second Team nonors after this year's ACC Tournament

Fresh off her best season at the helm of the California women's basketball team, Charmin Smith signed a contract extension in the summer of 2024 that will retain her through the 2028-29 season.

In her fifth year as head coach in 2023-24, the Golden Bears won their most overall (19) and conference (seven) games since the 2018-19 season. Smith also guided Cal into the postseason for the first time since 2018-19 as the Bears earned an at-large bid and a No. 2 seed in last year's inaugural NCAA Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament. Under Smith's guidance that season, the team also had its first weekend home and road sweeps of Pac-12 schools (both against Washington and Washington State) since 2018-19, swept Oregon for the first time since 2012-13 and set a program record for 3-pointers (282) in a season. The season sweeps of Oregon, Washington and Washington State marked the first time Cal has swept three different Pac-12 schools since 2017-18. The Bears also advanced to the quarterfinals of last year's Pac-12 Tournament for the first time since 2019-20. Smith was named ESPN's Coach of the Week on Jan. 8 of that season.

Entering last season Smith signed a Top 25 (ESPN) recruiting class that featured two ESPN HoopGurlz Top 100 players in Kamryn Mafua (54) and Zahra King (76) along with last year's Gatorade and MaxPreps Hawaii State Player of the Year Lola Donez

Smith is an award-winning coach, former professional player, and active board member who has dedicated her career to progressing equity and opportunity. The true definition of a trailblazer, Smith is the first Black Head Coach at the University of California Berkeley's women's basketball program history and is on a mission to leverage her platform to lead societal change through sports.

Smith's unwavering dedication to empowering players to surpass their potential, her commitment to enhancing the representation of Black individuals in the sport, and her resolute drive to inspire action toward racial justice solidify her position as an influential leader in basketball and beyond.

Regarded as one a 2024 and 2020 Top 100 Most Influential Figures in Women's College Basketball (Silver Waves Media), Smith's legacy at Cal Berkeley—beginning with her transition from Associate Head Coach to Head Coachhighlights her strategic acumen and commitment to player development. Her storied tenure includes a 2013 Final Four appearance and an impressive ten postseason appearances.

Currently serving on the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA), Smith is renowned for her role as a Board Member and co-chair of the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Committee. Her dedication extends far beyond the basketball court, as evidenced by her impactful contributions to the Cal Athletics Equity Inclusion and Diversity Task Force and her pivotal role in the Chancellor's Counsel for Students of Color and Multicultural Engagement.

Smith experienced a number of successes in her first year as head coach, leading the Golden Bears to three upsets over higher-ranked opponents. The first came in the form of a 4-point victory over No. 20 Arkansas on November 24 and then a win over No. 13 Arizona on the road in the regular season finale. The Bears completed their second upset in the same week as just four days later, they defeated 5-seeded and No. 22-ranked Arizona State in the opening round of the 2020 Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament in Las Vegas. The win over the Sun Devils made the Golden Bears just the second 12-seed to win a game in the Pac-12 Tournament.

Smith has helped coach the Bears to the top three individual seasons in program history. In her first two years in Berkeley, Cal set then-school records for wins in a season, finishing both years with 27-7 marks before Cal pushed itself into elite status with the record-breaking 32-4 Final Four campaign in 2012-13. The Bears also recorded their best Pac-12 record (17-1) and won their first conference regular-season crown that season. Smith has helped lead the Bears to the postseason in 11 of her 13 seasons and was also part of the staff that led the Bears to the 2010 WNIT championship.

Smith's previous roles at Stanford and Boston College allowed her to build upon impact, leading her teams to multiple NCAA appearances and historic victories. Her experience as a point guard for the WNBA's Minnesota Lynx and Seattle Storm later influenced her time as an Assistant Coach for the New York Liberty.

As a standout player Stanford Women's Basketball Team, Smith was a crucial component of the team's three NCAA Final Four Appearances and three Pac-10 Conference Championships between 1995 to 1997. Following her collegiate playing career, Smith joined the professional ranks in the ABL from 1997-98 as a member of the Portland Power and played three years in the WNBA, along with one year in the Swedish Basketball League.

She holds both master's and bachelor's degrees in Civil and Environmental Engineering from the University. Coupled with her impressive career in basketball, Smith also pursued the challenging discipline of Muay Thai martial arts. As a testament to her relentless spirit, Smith applies the lessons from her passion off the court to her coaching approach on the court.

Her leadership extends to a realm where the core values are honor and discipline, where she embodies the ethos that actions must follow words. And her steadfast commitment and achievements have set her apart to lead the future of sports.

In the loss to #6 Notre Dame at the ACC Tournament:

- Marta Suarez registered her third-straight double-double and sixth of the season with 14 points and 11 rebounds Lulu Twidale and Kayla Williams tossed in four and three 3-pointers respectively.
- Michelle Onyiah just missed out on her fourth straight double-double with 13 points and eight rebounds to go along with three blocks.
- The Golden Bears (25-8) held the Fighting Irish (26-4) to just four 3-pointers on 28.6%, well below their season average of 40.3%.

- Became 1 of just 6 players in women's college basketball history to acheive 400 3PTM and 2,500 career points
- Entered the NCAA's all-time top 10 list for career 3-pointers (currently ninth)
- Set Cal's single-season program record for 3-pointers
- To end the regular season, over her last four games Krimili is averaging 15.5 points per game on 48.8% shooting from the field and 51.4% from deep.
- Twidale's last three games to end the regular season have been her best stretch dishing the ball of her career with totals of 5-6-6 over those three games. The six assists are tied for her career high.
- Krimili is currently the nation's leader in both career triples (432) and most career games with at least five made 3-pointers (28) among active player. She ranks fourth in the NCAA in career points (2,576) among all active players which ranks 63rd all-time in NCAA DI women's basketball (since 1981-82).
- Krimili and Twidale are the best 3-point shooting duo in the nation. Krimili is ranked 10th (95) while Twidale is ranked 11th (93) (through Mar. 18). No other school has a duo who have combined for more made 3-pointers or rank in the top 30.
- Krimili and Twidale are two of only seven players in the NCAA with at least 20 games this season with three or more made 3-pointers (through Mar. 18). Krimili is third in the country with 21 such games.
- While Krimili currentyl holds Cal's single-season 3-point record at 95. Twidale's 93 triples this season rank second on the list.
- For the month of November, Twidale:
 - Ranked 5th in the country in 3-point makes
 - Posted three 20-point games
 - Led the country with eight games with 3+ 3-pointers
- For the month of December, Krimili:
 - Ranked 5th in the NCAA in total 3-pointers with 24
 - Ranked 9th in the country in 3PT % (min. 45 attempts) at 40.7%
 - Averaged 17.7 points per game
- Krimili is one of only two active players in the country with career averages of 41% from the field, 39% from downtown (min. 400 3PA) and 85% from the free throw line while averaging at least 16.0 points per game over at least three seasons. The other is UConn's Paige Bueckers.
- Marta Suarez has scored in double figures in all but four games during conference play averaging 13.8 points per game over that stretch along with averaging 7.8 rebounds per game - which both lead the team in ACC play.
 - Suarez is 1 of 5 players in the conference to finish in the top 25 in scoring, rebounding and field goal percentage

(45.2) during ACC play. Her 21 3-pointers in conference play rank second among the five players.

- Suarez's 40 3-pointers this season rank fourth among all forwards in the ACC.
- Suarez is one of only 14 forwards in the country and only one of three in the ACC shooting at least 46% from the field and 32% from deep (min. 100 3PTA).
- Williams has done a great job fascilitating and contributing to the team's offensive output this season. She is
 1 of just 4 players in the nation shooting at least 49.0% from the field, 39.0% from deep and totaling at least
 125 assists on the season. The other three are Paige Bueckers (UConn), Olivia Miles (Notre Dame) and Katie
 Dinnebier (Drake).
- Of Onyiah's career-high 11 double-doubles for the season, eight occurred during ACC play which finished second in the conference. She's registered a double-double in six of her last 10 games.
- Onyiah finished first in the ACC in field goal percentage for both overall (61.3) and conference games (63.0%).
- Onyiah is setting career single-season highs across several categories this year: FG%, rebounding (7.4), scoring (12.2) and double doubles (11).
- Of the 379 active players with 1,000 career points Onyiah is one of only 15 that have shot at least 54.0% and grabbed at least 800 rebounds over their career.
- Onyiah will finish on Cal's all-time top 10 lists for:
 - · Career FG% currently tied for fifth
 - Single-season FG% currently 3rd
 - · Career blocks currently fifth
 - Single-season blocks needs one to tie for 10th
- Over her last four games, Onyiah averaged 19.6ppg (on 64.0% shooting) and 9.5rpg.
- Noble has proven to be the team's defensive stopper and a key player off the bench as she has played double-digit minutes in 16 of the past 17 games and leads the team in reserve minutes. She is the team's leading rebounder off the bench with 99 rebounds grabbed so far this season.
- Gabrielle Abigor has earned her way into the primary backup center spot this season. Among freshmen in the ACC she ranks in the top 10 in blocks and rebounds despite totaling just 271 minutes - the fewest among the group - and not having started a game. Within freshmen in the ACC who have not started a game she ranks seend in blocks (10) and third in rebounds (74).
- In 3 of the losses against AP Top 25/receiving votes teams:
 - 5-point game with 5 minutes left against No. 14 North Carolina
 - · 6-point game with 4 minutes left against No. 6 Notre Dame
 - 1-point game at the 4:59 and 2:18 marks against Michigan State (RV)
- Prior to the game against Notre Dame in the ACC Tournament, the previous five games were one of Cal's best stretches of the season. During that span the Bears are averaging 10.6 3-pointers, 18.8 assists and just 13.6 turnovers per game while shooting 47.5% from the field and 40.8% from deep.
- Cal's 3-point shooting has come alive lately. After a seven-game stretch where it didn't reach double-figure triples, the Bears have hit 10+ in three of the past six games.
- Cal is 1 of only 6 ACC schools with five different players having scored 20+ points at least once in a game this season (others are Bsoton College, Duke, Notre Dame, Stanford and Virginia Tech).
- Cal is 1 of only 6 schools in the country and 1 of 3 in this year's NCAA Tournament to have five players averaging over 10 points per game.
- Cal's depth on the offensive side of the ball has been on display this season as five different Bears have led
 the team in scoring in a game.
- Cal's 22nd-ranked freshman class is comprised of two rookies who were part of ESPN's 2024 HoopGurlz Top 100 - Kamryn Mafua (No. 54) and Zahra King (No. 76) along with last year's Gatorade and MaxPreps Hawaii State Player of the Year Lola Donez and Gabby Abigor.
- The returning trio of Krimili, Marta Suarez and Twidale combined for 144 3-pointers last season which accounted for 51% of the team's total triples made.
- Despite missing nine games last season Krimili's 61 triples last season ranked ninth in the Pac-12 conference.
 During conference play she tied for the league lead with 47 3-pointers.
- Suarez proved to be one of the most versatile players on the team last season as she made impacts on both
 ends of the floor leading the team in rebounds (171) while ranking third in 3-point makes (42).
- In 2023-24, Suarez led the team with seven double-doubles, good for 10th in the Pac-12. She also led the team with 22 double-digit scoring games.
- Twidale was one of the best freshman in the Pac-12 last season as she was only 1 of 2 freshmen in the Pac-12 to either score 24 points or hit six triples in a game the other was USC's Juju Watkins. Twidale also posted three 20-point games in 2023-24 tied for 2nd in the Pac-12 among all freshmen.
- Graduate center Michelle Onyiah enters her fifth season with the Bears and has shown steady improvement in several categories each year with the team:
 - FG%: 46.9 (FR) -> 56.1 (SR)
 - Rebounds: 115 (FR) -> 212 (SR)






