TEAM NOTES

- Mississippi State enters the NCAA Championship for the fourth consecutive season, the longest streak in program
- The Bulldogs have made the tournament every season under HC Charlie Ewing, who is in his fifth year. The Bulldogs have advanced past the regional round in all but his first season, where the regional round was canceled due to inclement weather, and only the top six seeds advanced.
- Ewing has led the Bulldogs to six tournament titles, making him the winningest coach in program history.
- Kendall Griffin is in her first season as assistant coach for the Bulldogs. Griffin joins Mississippi State after spending the past two seasons at Indiana, where she helped lead the program to it's first Big 10 Championship in 30 years.
- Griffin spent four seasons at LSU and her graduate season at Lousiville during her college career.

- Experience Matters: The Bulldogs have five golfers who have carded action in the NCAA Championship.
- Ewing has led the team to six tournament titles during his time at Mississippi State, making him the most winningest coach in program history.
- The Bulldogs enter the Championship round after finishing fourth in the Gold Canyon Regional. Avery Weed, Izzy Pellot, Ana Pina Ortega and Chiara Horder all finished in the top 20 individually. This was only the third time all season State had four golfers finishin the top 20 of a tournament.
- State shot the second-lowest tournament score in program history at the PDI Intercollegiate (-23) and the sixth-lowest at the Chevron Collegiate (-19) to kick off the spring semester.
- In last years NCAA Championship, the Bulldogs finished 15th after advancing to the final round of stroke play.

- Career Match Play Record: 10-12-2 Has the best match play record of any Bulldog this season, winning 75% of her individual matches.
 - Has carded 11 par or better rounds on the 2024-25 season, the most since she transferred to Mississippi State from Texas Tech
 - Has shot 3-under in two rounds this season, her best rounds as a Bulldog.
 - Finished under par in the last fall event, The Ally (-2), and the PDI Intercollegiate (-3). Marked the first time she recorded back-to-back under-par tournaments since the 2022-23 season.
 - Carded her first round in the 60s as a Bulldog in the second round of the PDI Intercollegiate (69, -3).
 - Winner of the 120th Women's Amateur Championship.
 - Name is pronounced "KEY-are-uh Hoarder"

- Her best finish of the season occured at the PDI Intercollegiate (Feb. 2-4), where she finished 2-under par on the tournament after recording back-to-back 2-under rounds in the second and third days.
- 26 par or better rounds on her career good for eighth most career par or better rounds in program history.
- · Has recorded under par rounds in four of six rounds played in the spring.
- Shot her career Low-54 of 211 (-5) twice last season the first at the Bulldogs home event, The Ally, earning her best career finish. The second was the NCAA Bermuda Run Regional, earning a T10 finish and helping the Bulldogs advance to their third straight NCAA Championship.
- Name is pronounced "sir-AH-pUH Jah-tah-moo-knee", but also goes by the nickname SJ.

- Finished under par in her first six rounds of golf in the spring, the longest streak of under-par rounds in her career. Four of those rounds were in the 60s.
- Has collected seven rounds in the 60s in her career, five of which have come this season.
- Has played the most rounds at Mississippi State of any Bulldog on the roster.
- Last name is pronounced "puh-lot", not "pellet"

- Accepted an invite to play in the Augusta National Women's Amateur on April 2-5.
- Currently the #39 ranked golfer according to Scoreboard by Clippd.
