(TO PROVE A BOX SCORE: For either side, total at bats plus sacrifices, bases on balls and hit by pitcher should equal runs scored left on bases and opponents' errors. . . NOTES: Semi-colons used only between double plays. Separate paragraphs should be made for each game. The decision pitcher's records should be listed on the same line as his game performance, i.e.(W,L-14-1). . . In the event a game is won in the last of the 9th or an extra inning a notation should be made in the first paragraph of the summary following the word "Game." Example: "The home team won in the bottom of the 10th." . . . "LOB" figures; i.e. "Two out when winning run scored in 12th." NOTES ON GAME (Write Notes on Game) . . . List all notable events as hits that decide games, or fielding plays that prevent a game from being decided. Do not list routine plays which appear in the summary. Play names must be spelled out. . . . Do not list errors unless they are unusual. . . . List all players who played in the game, and why; games officially protested and conservative estimate of crowd.
