(TO PROVE A BOX SCORE: For hits, i.e., total at bats plus sacrifices, bases on balls and hit by pitcher should equal runs scored, left on base and opponents' putouts, etc.) NOTES: Semi-colons used only between double plays. Separate paragraphs should be made starting with errors and two base hits; also footnotes for pinch-hitters and pinch-runners which will be carried horizontally. The decision pitcher's records should be listed on the same line as his game performance, i.e., (W, 14-11). In the event a pitcher is used in more than one game, the record should be listed on the line of the game in which he pitched the most. The game is won in the last of the 9th or an extra inning a notation should be made in the first paragraph of the game, i.e., "LOB" figures, i.e., "Two out when winning run scored" (W, 1-0, 9th, 2 out). The "LOB" figure should be placed in parentheses on the Back Side.) Give features such as hit by pitcher, error, error-decided, error-decided, also extra fine work by pitchers.
