Figure 1 consists of eight panels, labeled A through H, each showing a line graph of bacterial growth over time. The y-axis for all panels is 'log<sub>10</sub> CFU/g' ranging from 0 to 8. Panel E (100% Citric acid) shows growth reaching about 5.0 log<sub>10</sub> CFU/g. Panel F (100% Acetic acid) shows growth reaching about 4.5 log<sub>10</sub> CFU/g. Panel G (100% Lactic acid) shows growth reaching about 4.0 log<sub>10</sub> CFU/g. Panel H (100% Propionic acid) shows the lowest growth, reaching about 3.5 log<sub>10</sub> CFU/g. In all panels, the growth starts at approximately 1.5 log<sub>10</sub> CFU/g at 0 hours.

(TO PROVE A BOX SCORE: For each side, total at bats plus sacrifices, bases on balls and hit by pitcher should equal runs scored left on base plus "opponents'" putouts. . . NOTES: Semi-colons used only between double plays. Separate paragraphs should be made starting with errors and two base hits; also footnotes for pinch-hitters and pinch-runners which will be carried horizontally . . . The decision pitcher's records should be listed on the same line as his game performance, i.e. (W, 14-11). . .
