TO PROVE A BOX SCORE: For either side, total at bats plus sacrifices, bases on balls and hit by pitcher should equal runs scored, left on bases and opponents' putouts.) . . . NOTES: Semi-colons used only between double plays. Separate paragraphs should be made starting with errors and two base hits; also footnotes for pinch-hitters and pinch-runners which will be carried horizontally. . . . The decision pitcher's records should be listed on the same line as his game performance, i.e. (W,14-11). . . . In the event a game is won in the last of the 9th or an extra inning a notation should be made in the first paragraph of the summary following the notation "Game won in extra inning" and the winning pitcher scored in 12th. . . . NOTES ON GAME (Write Notes on Back Side): Give features such as hits that decide games, or fielding errors that decide games, or errors by the pitcher. . . . Plays which appear in the summary above take care of themselves; therefore, those not showing are the ones which should be listed. . . . Use first names. Mention injuries, players put out of game, and why; games officially protested and conservative estimate of crowd.
