TO PROVE A BOX SCORE: For each side, total at bats plus sacrifices, bases on balls and hit by pitcher should equal runs scored, left on bases and opponents' putouts. . . . **NOTES:** Semi-colons used only between double plays. Separate paragraphs should be made starting with errors and two base hits; also footnotes for pinch-hitters and pinch-runners which will be carried horizontally. . . . The decision pitcher's records should be listed on the same line as his game performance, i.e. (W, L+11). . . . In the event a game is won in the last of the 9th or an extra inning a notation should be made in the first paragraph of the summary following the "LOB" figures; i.e. "Lost out when winning run scored in 12th." . . . **NOTES ON GAME** (Write Notes on Back Side): Give features such as "Pitcher's record broken," "Biggest comeback," "Biggest shutout," "Biggest crowd," "Biggest home run" in the summary in the margin above take care of themselves; therefore, those not showing are the ones which should be listed here. Please use first names. Mention injuries, players put out of game, and why; games officially protested and conservative estimate of crowd.
