TO PROVE A BOX SCORE: For each side, total at bats plus sacrifices, bases on balls and hit by pitcher should equal runs scored, left on bases and opponents' putouts. NOTES: Semi-colons used only between double plays. Separate paragraphs should be made starting with errors and two base hits; also footnotes for pinch-hitters and pinch-runners. Be careful of errors. . . . The decision pitcher's record should be listed on the same line as his game performance, i.e. (W,14-11). . . . In the event a game is won in the last of the 9th or an extra inning a notation should be made in the first paragraph of the summary following the game. . . . If a team scores two out when winning run scored in 12th. . . . NOTES ON GAME (Write Notes on Back Side): Give features such as hits that decide game; errors; errors by pitcher; errors by pitcher. . . . Give names of players which appear in the summary above take care of themselves; therefore, those not showing are those which should be stated here. Please use first names. Mention injuries, players put out of game, and why; games officially protested and conservative estimate of crowd. . . .
