TO PROVE A BOX SCORE: For each side, total at bats plus sacrifices, bases on balls and hit by pitcher should equal runs scored, left on bases and opponent's putouts. . . . NOTES: Semi-colons used only between double plays. Separate paragraphs should be made starting with errors and two base hits; also footnotes for pinch-hitters and pinch-runners which will be carried horizontally. . . . The decision pitcher's records should be listed on the same line as his game performance, i.e. (W,14-11). . . .
