Figure 1 is a Northern blot analysis showing 18S rRNA levels in various tissues. The blot is divided into two columns of lanes, labeled A through H. Lanes A, C, E, and G show strong, dark bands, indicating high levels of 18S rRNA. Lanes B, D, F, and H show very faint bands, indicating low levels of 18S rRNA. The tissues corresponding to each lane are: A: testis, B: heart, C: skeletal muscle, D: liver, E: kidney, F: brain, G: spleen, and H: thymus.

TO PROVE A BOX SCORE: For elvish side, total at bats plus sacrifices, based on balls and hits by pitcher should equal runs scored left on bases and opponents' putouts. NOTES: Semi-colons used only between double plays. Setate paragraph's should be made starting with errors and two base hits; also footnotes for pinch-hitters and pinch-runners which will be carried horizontally. . . . The decision pitcher's records should be listed on the same line as his game performance, i.e. (W/L+11). . . . In the event a game is won in the last of the 9th or an extra inning a notation should be made in the first paragraph of the summary following the "LOB" figures; i.e. "Two out when winning run scored in 12th." NOTES ON GAME (Write Notes on Back Side): Give features such as hits that decide games, or fielding plays that prove decisive; also extra line work by pitchers. Plays which appear in the summary should be made in the notes, therefore, use first names of players. Do not use first names of players who are out. Mention injuries, players out of game, and why; games officially protested and conservative estimate of crowd.
